This is a Primitive Event and the rules were established when it was organized in 1993. They are published in each shoot flyer that is sent out and in many of the reminders. Your participation in the event indicates that you accept those rules. If you bring guests, you need to make them aware of the rules and they need to follow them.

TGRR Rules:

1740 – 1780 period dress is required – period. This is not a jeans shoot. The only exception to period dress is footwear due to weather conditions.

A trade gun is defined as a flintlock smoothbore – 54 caliber or larger, with no rear site above the plane of the barrel and no set-triggers

No optics attached or detached. That includes the diopters and iris dots that attach to the lens of your glasses.

Aggregate score is based on best five of six shoots.

Hammer Falls: 2 on round ball shots and 1 on clay bird shots.

Scoring will equal 200 points;

broken down as follows:

12 round ball shots - 10 points each

4 clay birds - 10 points each

Knife & Hawk - 15 points each

Fire starting - 10 points

Tiebreaker is the choice of the host club and may be part of the round ball shoot.
