- Registration starts at 8:30 shooting starts at 9:00 am.
 - Coffee and donuts for the early birds.
- Come Friday night and camp out in LMLGC's primitive camp Ground.
 - Primitive attire is welcome, but not required; pictures will be taken.
 - Entrance fee is 11 bucks per shooter, with 1 buck going for a 50/50 best tie breaker.
 - Compete in Black Powder rifle, trade gun, pistol/Revolver; with plunder for the top 5 scores in each class (3 classes).
 - Plus junior class 17 and under.
 - Sponsor a junior and they shoot for free.
 - A junior may shoot for free if they don't keep score.
 - In-lines welcome, but must use patched round ball, loose powder
 - Bring enough balls and powder for 30 shots.
 - Shoot held no-matter the weather.
 - Hot coffee, lunch, and tall tales to be served around the camp fire which is included.


