LANSING MUZZLE LOADING GUN CLUB COMMITTEES

1. **GROUNDS:** Maintains all building structures at the Sciota Station range, mows and trims grounds, assures that the well and other components of the water system are up to code, maintains the electrical system, keeps the tractor and other mowing equipment in good condition, and arranges cleanup and garbage disposal after all major events.

2. **KITCHEN:** Maintains the kitchen, refrigerators, freezers, and stoves. Organizes menus for Open Shoots and other club events, and prepares and sells food to competitors.

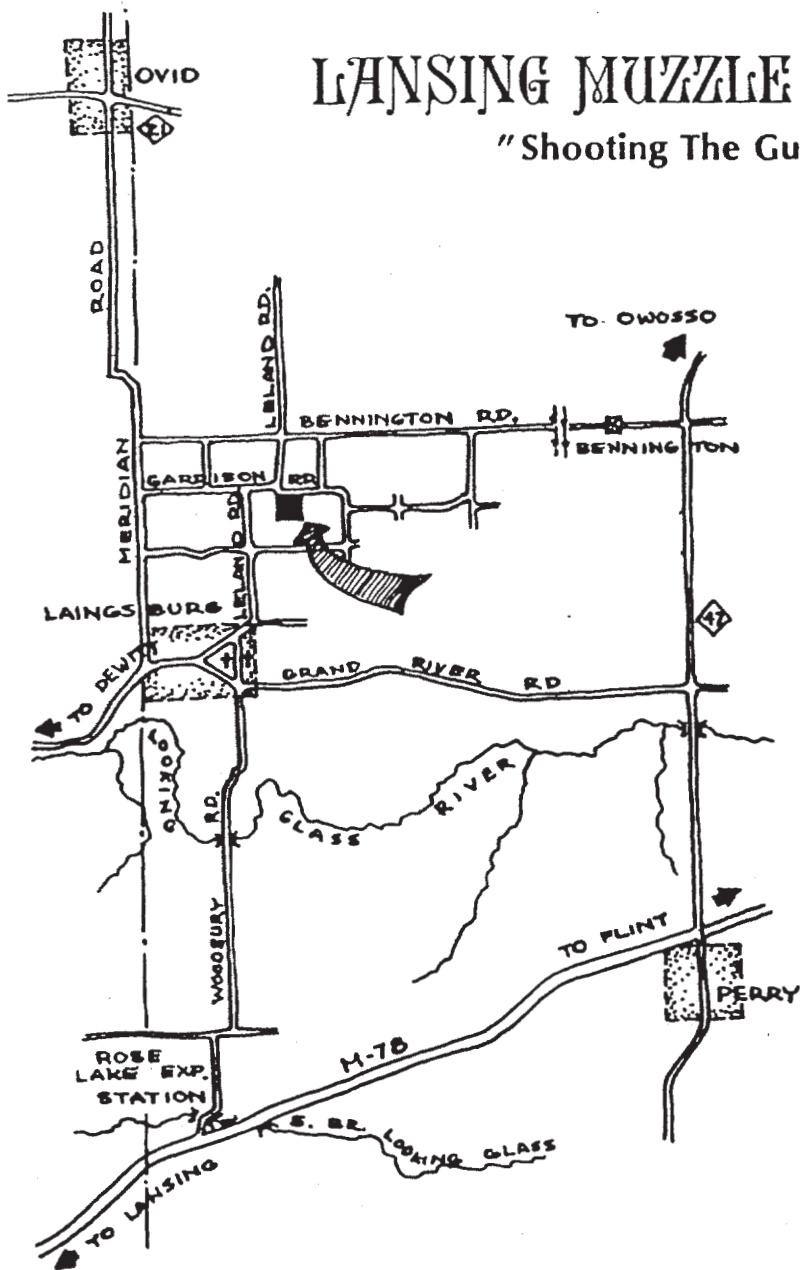
3. **PRIMITIVE:** Mows and trims the Primitive Range and maintains metal silhouettes and knife and hawk targets. Conducts the primitive matches at the Spring and Fall Open Shoots and obtains and awards prizes.

4. **SHOOT:** Maintains the range public address system, stringers, backers, and loading benches. Provides staplers and clipboards at the Spring and Fall Open Shoots. Supervises the firing line at monthly club shoots and at the Open Shoots and assures compliance with National Muzzle Loading Rifle Association rules. Trains line officers.
 - A. **TARGETS:** Purchases, stores, marks, and collates targets for all monthly club shoots and the Spring and Fall Open Shoots.
 - B. **SCORING:** Registers competitors, scores all targets, and posts scores at the Spring and Fall Open Shoots.
 - C. **MEDALS:** Designs, orders, and awards medals at all club shoots.

5. **SHOTGUN:** Maintains traps, electrical system, and loading benches at the shotgun range. Purchases and stores clay targets. Supervises and scores shotgun matches at the Spring and Fall Open Shoots and awards medals and prizes.

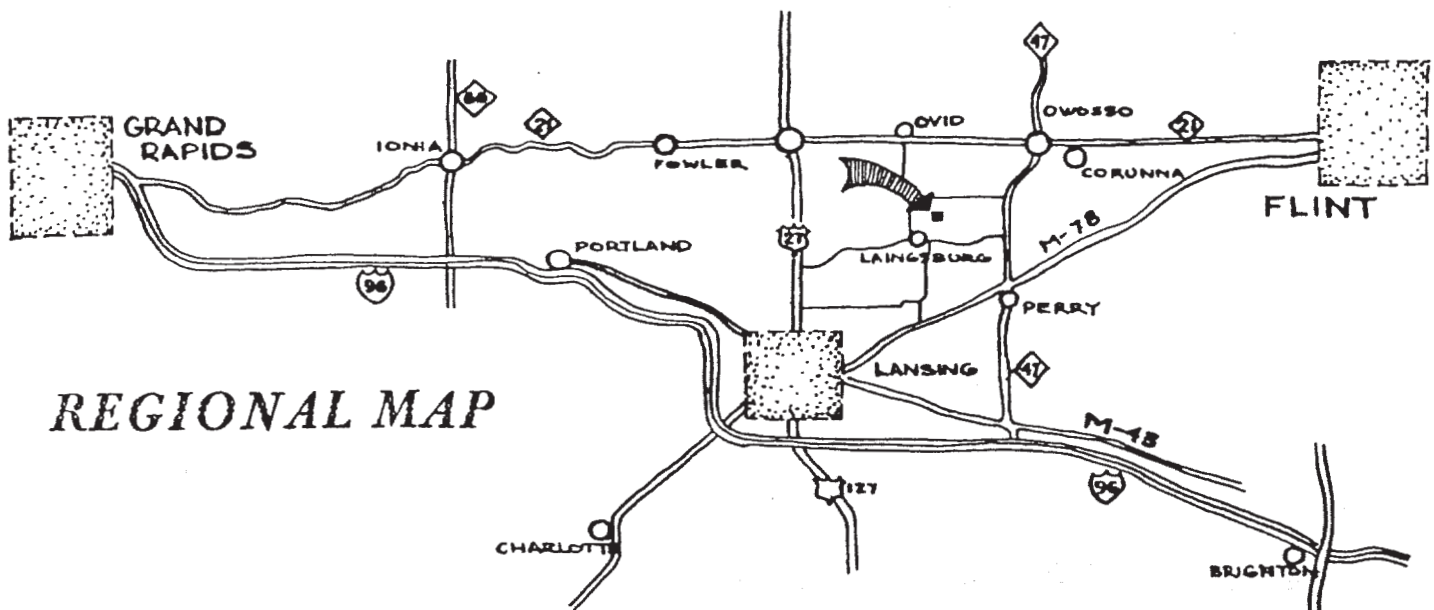
LANSING MUZZLE LOADING GUN CLUB
